

# RAMAKRISHNA KUTIR AN OVERVIEW





Swami Vivekananda says – Where are you searching for God keeping aside the Living Gods? 'Daridra devo bhava, Murkha devo bhava' – the poor, the illiterate, the ignorant, and the afflicted – let these be your God. Know that service to these alone is the highest religion.

Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission are worldwide, non-political, non-sectarian spiritual organizations engaged in various humanitarian and social service activities for over a century. Inspired by the ideals of renunciation and service, the monks and lay devotees of the Math and Mission serve millions of men, women and children, without any distinction of caste, religion or race, because they see the living God in them.

Swami Vivekananda inspired his brother disciples revered Swami Shivananda and Swami Turiyananda to establish an Ashrama in Almora. Realizing the dream of Swamiji, Ramakrishna Kutir in Almora was established in 1916.

Dedicated to the ideology of Swami Vivekananda, Ramakrishna Kutir at Almora has taken up various projects to benefit society at large and specifically the underprivileged. The projects have been depicted on the following page.

The charitable social services are rendered with the relentless support of **5 monastic members and about 7 working staff** across various areas. Following are the prominent community beneficial activities undertaken by Ramakrishna Kutir, Almora every year:





Winter Relief: Almora being a hill station, the minimum temperature in peak winter sees subzero. Ramakrishna Kutir arranges relief camps prior to winter every year in the villages in and around Almora district to distribute blankets and garments to the under-privileged people.

Rain Relief: The other odd to the habitants of Almora region is massive landslides during monsoon. This causes severe damage to the residential houses every year. In 2022-23, Ramakrishna Kutir provided construction materials to 20 such affected families for the rehabilitation of their houses.






Ration-kit distribution: Food grains & other essential edibles are distributed among the underprivileged every year irrespective of caste, creed, or religion. During the lockdown owing to Corona Virus (COVID-19) outbreak, Ramakrishna Kutir arranged to donate adequate cereals and groceries to 175 families.

Pecuniary Aid: Financial support is also provided throughout the year in form of educational aid by providing scholarship to needy students covering the cost of their tuition fees & books etc., financial assistance for the marriage of orphan girls, medical aid for the poor and so on.



Apart from the aforesaid projects, Ramakrishna Kutir, Almora organized a series of educational, spiritual & cultural events during May and June 2023, to celebrate the 125th anniversary of Swami Vivekananda's return from Chicago and the foundation of Ramakrishna Mission. A few events to name were —







Intra-collegiate seminars & competitions involving 2500 students from 33 schools & colleges of Almora district were held.

Inspirational workshops and lectures on topics such as youth and women empowerment, medical service, stress management etc. were held at Almora Medical College, Pant Nagar University, SSJ University, Army Cantonment, Institute of Hotel Management & so on.





Release of new website, book & documentary: The new website for Ashrama- almora.rkmm.org was inaugurated on 24 May'23, A book titled 'JnanaVriksha ka Punarutthan' & a documentary titled 'Footsteps of Swamiji in Devbhoomi' were released in separate events as well.

**Spiritual Discourses**: Classes on Vedantic Sciptures, Ramcharitmanas, Life of Swami Vivekananda & guided meditation sessions were held at many places.





'Swami Vivekananda Circuit' Parikrama: A 9 days long parikrama of the places in Uttarakhand blessed by the footfall of Swami Vivekananda involving 75 Monks of Ramakrishna order and 50 devotees was conducted as the final event of the celebrations. Meetings, discourses & youth seminars were held at all these places.

Our Namaskars to you all!

Through the decades, Ramakrishna Kutir, Almora has been incrementally building its capacity to cater to the social and spiritual needs of the local people as well as the visitors who come from all parts of the country and abroad.

In our efforts to serve the underprivileged, we provide financial assistance in form of medical aid to those who can't afford treatment & medicines; scholarships to needy students; assistance in marriage of orphan girls and so on. We also distribute winter garments & blankets to the underprivileged families every winter. At times of distress, such as during Covid & other natural calamities, we provide ration-kits to the distressed families. For those who houses are damaged during heavy rains due to landslides, we provide construction materials to help them rehabilitate.

Within the Ashrama campus we run a small hostel for students who come from poor families of Uttarakhand's remote villages to study in Almora's universities. Along with their residence & fooding, we also bear all their tuition related expenses. A public library has also been open to all visitors since the inception of the Ashrama more than a century ago. Many eminent personalities including the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shree Narendra Modi, Former Chief Minister of Uttarakhand Shree Bhagat Singh Koshyari and others have spent many days in the Ashrama using the library and other facilities during their student days.

We conduct seminars and workshops across educational institutions in & around Almora to spread the message of 'nation building through character building' based on Swami Vivekananda's teachings. In this regard, we are planning to start regular study circles for the local youth to engage them in a more focused way.

The Ashrama came into existence in the early decades of the twentieth century. Many of the buildings in the Ashrama are from the pre-independence era and are in need of extensive repairs and expansion. Prominent among those buildings is the main office building which was the first structure to come up when the Ashrama was built in 1916. This building has been blessed by the holy presence of numerous saints and eminent personalities. The staff house, the hostel building and the guest house are all in need of a thorough renovation.

The Ashrama being located on a steep slope is prone to landslides during the rainy season and hence, the need to protect the buildings by constructing retaining walls is paramount. To this end, every year, we add to the existing length of the walls.

Also, because of the steepness, one has to navigate through hundreds of stairs to reach the Ashrama from the main road. We have been planning to construct a motorable road and/ or a couple of elevators to improve the accessibility especially for the sick, the aged & the physically challenged.

## **ANNEXURE**

## **Details of proposed activities**

We plan to expand our activities and build infrastructure, where we depend on charity from generous individuals and philanthropic organizations like yours. Ramakrishna Kutir, Almora is eligible to receive funds under the CSR scheme as per the rules of Government of India. Our planned projects and activities are mentioned below. You are free to choose one or multiple segments and help us with financial support in making this world a better place:

## **ANNUAL ACTIVITIES**

Medical Aid: The local people, who cannot afford medical treatment approach us for financial assistance through the year. We proactively coordinate their admission and treatment in the local hospitals along with the cost of medicines. We have put a yearly provision of Fifteen Lac Rupees

Library: A public library in the Ashrama campus has been operating for more than a century. We recently shifted the library to a new and bigger building to attract & encourage the local population into developing a reading habit. The library contains many old & rare books in its collections of more than 5000 titles across diverse subjects. We are now planning to digitize the library and looking to hire a permanent librarian to make the drive successful. The provisional cost for this project is approximately Twenty Lac Rupees, which includes a fixed deposit of ten lac to manage the yearly running cost.

Students' Scholarship & Student Hostel: We get regular visits of needy parents for assistance towards the cost of their wards' education. We have a system of extending scholarships every year to well performing school & college going students, particularly girls from underprivileged families.

Additionally, for a few graduate & post-graduate students coming from remote villages of Uttarakhand, who get enrolled in Soban Singh Jeena University at Almora, we also provide fooding and lodging inside the Ashrama to facilitate their studies along with their tuition fees, cost of books and other stationary items. Looking at the past few years, we have kept a yearly provision of **Thirty-Two Lac Rupees**.

Youth Study Circle: We have been conducting various activities to engage and motivate the local youth on Swami Vivekananda's ideals of 'nation building through character building'. We have built the Shivananda multipurpose audio-visual hall in the top-floor of the library building to further this cause. We are planning a series of lectures and competitions to be organized on a fortnightly basis. To mobilize these circles, the yearly budget has been kept as Ten Lac Rupees.

Welfare & Relief activities for local population: We are involved in various welfare activities like ration distribution to the under-privileged families, blanket and sweater distribution to needy people of Almora & nearby villages every winter, providing school uniform to the needy students and feeding the hungry people. We also provide financial assistance for marriage of needy orphan girls. Looking at the past few years, we have kept a yearly provision of Thirty Lac Rupees.

Rehabilitation of damaged Houses: Almora is situated on a mountainous terrain where heavy rains often lead to landslides and damages to the houses. It is the poor who are the worst affected. We assist in reconstruction and rehabilitation of their houses by providing materials as well as technical supervision for the efficient completion of the work. Looking at the past few years, we have kept a yearly provision of Thirty-Five lac Rupees to be able to help around 10 houses.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

Restoration of the 107-Year-Old Heritage Office Building: Ramakrishna Kutir, Almora was established in 1916. The 107-year-old wooden structured office building is one of the first structures constructed in the Ashrama. The building has been blessed by the footprints of many saints and eminent personalities, who have worked & stayed here. At present, it serves as the main office as well as the kitchen and dining hall. It is currently in a dilapidated state, posing serious safety concerns. Also considering the heritage value of the building, immediate reinstatement has become an absolute necessity for its sustenance.

An extension to the building has also been proposed to cater to the present needs by expanding the dining hall and constructing a few rooms at the lower ground floor. We are consulting a renowned conservation architect to inspect the building and provide proper guidance on the reinstatement process. The provisional cost as certified by the architect is **One Crore and Thirty-Five Lac Rupees**.


Motorable Road from main road to Ashrama: The Ashrama is situated on the steep slope of a hill. The difference in altitude between the upper & lower main road is almost 300 feet. The series of stairs make it very difficult for the elderly, sick and physically challenged people to reach the temple, office and other spaces in the Ashrama. We are looking at building a motorable road of almost 250 Mtrs. length to connect the Ashrama from the main road for light motor vehicles as well as to act as a ramp for pedestrians. The provisional cost is **One Crore and Fifty Lac Rupees.** 



'Vivekananda Bhawan'- Students' Home cum Car Parking Lot: We provide free of charge accommodation, food & study materials including stationery items to the under-privileged graduation & post-graduation students coming from the remote hill regions of Uttarakhand, who come to study at Almora's Universities. Background check is run prior to approval for each student. Currently we have four such students, who have been accommodated in a 75-year-old building, which is in need of extensive repairs.

Beyond the academic requirements, the students receive training in gardening, music, public speaking and many such activities to develop their personality and character. The Ashrama provides a holistic environment with value education to enable these students to become valued citizens of India.

Requests from such under-privileged promising students is progressively increasing but, we are not in a position to grant due to insufficient rooms inside Ashrama premises. Also, as the current hostel building is in a poor condition, the construction of one new building dedicated to those students has become essential. Accordingly, we got the plan sanctioned for a two storied building, comprising 4 rooms on ground floor and 3 rooms on first floor, with a total capacity of 14 people. The rooftop of the building shall be used as a car-parking for the motorable road. Along with furniture, elevator & approach road, the total provisional cost as certified by the architect is approx. One Crore Thirty-Seven Lac Rupees.



Installation of Elevator: The Ashrama is located on a steep slope, with a drop of almost 300 feet between the upper and the lower road. The temple, the library, the dining hall and the various buildings of residence for devotees, guests and monks are located at different levels, separated by almost 30 floors in between. The hostel building is located at the lowest level, making it most difficult for the students.

Amongst the visitors and devotees, many are aged or sick. Consequently, they find it difficult to climb more than 200 stairs to access the different facilities at the Ashrama. Further, carriage of materials including vegetables & groceries for the kitchen and materials for construction etc. becomes a great challenge. It is therefore felt necessary to install an elevator for providing easy accessibility.

The elevator will have a capacity of six passengers and would be wheel-chair friendly. Along with the elevator shaft & platform, the structural engineer has provided an estimate of approx. **Twenty-Four Lac Rupees.** 


**Staff Quarters:** The existing building, which is almost 90 years old, is in a very poor health. So, there is a need to renovate and extend the structure to accommodate more staffs. The provisional cost is **Thirty-Seven Lac Rupees.** 

Retaining Walls: Our Ashrama is situated on the steep slope of a hill. This instability of the landscape makes it susceptible to landslides during heavy rainfalls. All the buildings within Ashrama premises can get dislodged if multi-level retaining walls are not built. Every year, we have been progressively stabilizing certain areas of the Ashrama by constructing retaining walls.

For the coming year, we propose to construct retaining walls of a total length of approximately 18,000 cubic feet @ Rs.240 per cubic foot, adding up to approx. **Forty-Three Lac Rupees.** 

Guest House Building for guests and devotees: The existing guest houses are inadequate as well as very old. Despite renovations from time to time, we are unable to cater to the growing requests from guests and devotees, who visit the Ashrama for spiritual & educational purposes. We plan to construct a three storied building covering almost 5500 Sq. ft. with all the basic facilities for a comfortable stay for the guests. The provisional cost along with the furniture & fittings based on cost per sq. feet comes to approx. One Crore and Sixty-Five Lac Rupees.

Swami Vivekananda Dwar: When Swami Vivekananda returned from the West after his glorious run, spreading the message of Vedanta & universal harmony, the residents of Almora gathered by thousands in his welcome. They made him sit on a big white horse and laid out a 3 km long red carpet in his honour. In reply to this reception, Swamiji said- "These Mountains are associated with the best memories of our race...where Rishis lived, where philosophy was born...this is the spot which I want to select as one of the great centres to teach this universal religion". In a bid to invigorate the youth and the old, the locals & the visitors- all alike with the flaming ideas of Swami Vivekananda, we plan on constructing a befitting VIVEKANANDA DWAR at the entrance of the serene hill town. We have worked out the details with local administration to build this glorious memorial for Almora, which got blessed by three different visits of Swami Vivekananda between 1890 and 1898. The structure with a statue of Swamiji on a horse, with elements of religious harmony & cultural diversity has been planned to be 43.66 ft in height & 51.5 ft in width. The approx. cost is Forty Lac Rupees.



Electrification: The electric wiring of the Ashrama in most places is several decades old. The naked overhead wires have been a cause of several hazards in the last few years. The wantonness of the monkeys makes it further worrisome and has resulted in accidents, some of which were fatal for these animals. In addition, the extreme climate of the region- sub-zero temperatures, torrential rains & storms compel us to go for a closed-cable underground wiring from internal electric poles as well as from the main transformer to safeguard against the vagaries of nature. Along with circuit breakers & all other fittings, our consulting electrical engineer has given us a quotation of **Ten Lac Rupees**.

**Solar Panel:** To promote renewable energy as well as to become energy self-sufficient, we are proposing the installation of solar panels at rooftops of all buildings which receive good sun light. This shall help us reduce our annual expenses in the form of electric bills as well as our carbon footprint. The tentative cost given by an established company is **Eighteen Lac Rupees.**
